01. APPLICATION

02. REPORT CARD

Participants must be a high school student in good standing based on academic performance and good character

03. ATTENDANCE RECORD

Participants must provide a document showing a good attendance record

04. REFERENCES

Professional individuals (unrelated to the applicant) who can vouch for your character

BMLDI

The Black Male Leadership Development Institute (BMLDI) is a FREE program that brings African American boys in grades nine through twelve together to participate in a year-long program designed to increase educational and leadership opportunities for the selected participants.

Students engage in a week long residential program on the Slippery Rock University campus.

The weeklong program is followed by the BMLDI Saturday Institute, which is an ongoing year-round series of activities and workshops.
